This 40-hour course covers theory and practical operation of fire department aerial apparatus, including rules and regulations of emergency vehicle operation, vehicle maintenance, aerial device design and construction, weight distribution theory, and the limitations of aerial devices. Practical sessions will address the operation of aerial apparatus, operation of aerial devices, and vehicle placement at emergency incidents.
