This 24-hour class meets the requirements of NFPA 1670: *“Standard on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Incidents, Trench Rescue, Awareness and Operations Level”*.

Performance of all required practical skills are necessary to receive a certificate. This is a performance and skill driven class; start and end times are for reference only.

Topics of instruction include:

- Incident management
- Collapse indicator recognition
- Atmospheric monitoring & testing, ventilation, and de-watering operations
- Shoring system construction and installation for straight trenches, including lumber and pneumatic systems
- Patient packaging and extrication

Students are required to provide helmets, gloves, steel toe boots, and safety glasses

Knee and elbow pads, headlamps and/or flashlights are recommended

Personal equipment must be NFPA and ANSI compliant
