DESCRIPTION:

This 16-hour class meets the requirements of NFPA 1670: *“Standard on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Incidents, Trench Rescue, Technician Level”*. Performance of all required practical skills are necessary to receive a certificate. This is a performance and skill driven class; start and end times are for reference only.

Topics of instruction include:

- Incident management
- Collapse indicator recognition
- Atmospheric testing & monitoring, ventilation, and de-watering operations
- Shoring system construction and installation for intersecting trenches, including lumber and pneumatic systems
- Construction of load stabilization systems
- Patient, packaging and extrication

PROOF OF COMPLETION OF TRENCH RESCUE “OPERATIONS LEVEL” FROM A STATE OF FLORIDA CERTIFIED GROUND-BASED TRAINING FACILITY IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE PRESENTED AT TIME OF REGISTRATION

**Students are required to provide helmets, gloves, steel toe boots, and safety glasses
Knee and elbow pads, headlamps and/or flashlights are recommended
Personal equipment must be NFPA and ANSI compliant.
